

# AUTUMN TERM CURRICULUM PLAN


**NURSERY 2020-21**

We plan and resource our curriculum in seven areas of learning, building on what they already know and take their learning forward.

## Areas of learning and experience

<b>Personal, social and emotional development</b>
<p>The children will be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Settling in within their new environment.</li> <li>Beginning to develop an understanding of class rules and expectations regarding behaviour.</li> <li>To use the toilet independently.</li> <li>Encouraged to zip up their own coats</li> <li>Learning how to look after their property such as hats, wellies, jumpers and gloves.</li> <li>Beginning to develop an understanding of how to use indoor and outdoor equipment safely and independently.</li> <li>Learning that people celebrate in different ways as we explore the festivals of Eid, Christmas</li> </ul>

<b>Communication, language and literacy</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Talk confidently to each other and to the adults</li> <li>Take turns when speaking and listening to others.</li> <li>Join in with stories, rhymes and rhythmic activities.</li> <li>Retell familiar stories in the correct sequence.</li> <li>Begin to recognise and write their name independently.</li> <li>Listen attentively and respond appropriately to what they hear.</li> <li>Begin to handle books correctly.</li> </ul> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>

<b>Maths</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Accurately count objects and recognise numbers up to ten.</li> <li>Order and use numbers up to 10 confidently.</li> <li>Explore and talk about shapes and colours in their environment.</li> <li>Explore measurement of height, weight, length, capacity and time.</li> </ul> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>

## Understanding of the world

<b>The World</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explore ourselves.</li> <li>Explore sand, water, dough, paint and collage, materials.</li> <li>Take part in activities to encourage conversations about what they 'see', 'hear' and 'feel'.</li> </ul>

<b>Technology</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use an iPad to enhance their learning.</li> <li>Operate simple ICT equipment such as CD players, bee bots and cameras.</li> </ul>

<b>People and Communities</b>
<p>The children will be learning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To talk about family members and people who are important to them.</li> <li>To recall and talk about their past experiences.</li> </ul>

<b>Expressive Arts and Design</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Explore different materials and methods to create pictures.</li> <li>Use glue to stick materials to paper.</li> <li>Play a range of musical instruments.</li> <li>Play with small world resources to create their own stories.</li> <li>Use the role play area to act out scenarios from their own experiences or imagination.</li> <li>Make up dances in response to music.</li> </ul> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>

<b>Physical development</b>
<p>The children will be encouraged to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Join in with a variety of outdoor games to develop physical skills such jumping, climbing, throwing, kicking etc...</li> <li>Use outdoor equipment appropriately such as bikes and scooters.</li> <li>Develop skills needed for handwriting by threading beads, using sewing cards, exercising fingers and using scissors</li> <li>Use scissors to cut on a line</li> </ul> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>

<b>Links with home</b>
<p>We will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be available to discuss each child as needed with the parents</li> <li>Send a newsletter via Parent mail each week, keeping parents informed of events in the School and relevant dates.</li> <li>Ask you to continue to support your child's learning at home via Nursery Home Learning on Facebook</li> <li>Contact parents to discuss child's progress and how they have settled into Nursery.</li> </ul> <div style="text-align: right;">  </div>
