Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope you are all keeping safe and well at this time and I also hope you are coping with the isolation you now find yourselves in. Please don't worry too much about home schooling it is more important for us that you and your children remain safe and well, We will have plans in place once school has reopened to catch your children up. All children will be in the same boat so don't think that your child is disadvantaged. It is a worrying time for them and it is important that you enjoy your family time.

Havering Catering have informed us of their plans to provide free school meals to pupils that are entitled to them. They will issue food packs that can be collected from the school reception. We will inform you of the collection date as soon as we know when that is.

The kitchen team will prepare and pack the food into large paper bags and give to us to distribute to parents.

They have tried to keep the packs as neutral as possible to suit all dietary requirements with easy to use ingredients that can produce quick lunches at home.

The pack will include

- 1x Princes Tuna Chunks in Brine 185g
- 1 Baked Beans- 400g Heinz
- 2 x Cheese Triangles
- 3x Jacket Potatoes
- 1 x Loaf of Bread- Wholemeal
- 5 x Pieces of Fruit- Apple, Pear, Banana or Satsuma
- 1 x 3 Long Life Yoghurts Mixed flavours
- 2 x Assorted Biscuits

The above pack is for 1 child, so those with more than one child will get a larger pack. Please let us know by email office@crowlands.havering.sch.uk or call the school office 01708743402 if you will require a pack and for how many children who attend Crowlands are in your family. Orders must be placed by midday on Friday 27th March 2020. If you do not order by this time you will not be able to collect a pack.
